Q. I have numerous old brass and copper pieces that were badly stained due to flood damage. I've tried cleaning them with various brass polishes but the stains won't budge and seem impossible to remove. 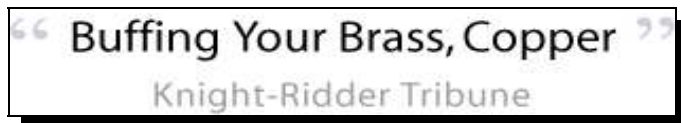
Q. What can I use to clean, and restore the shine to, brass bowls, vases, bells, incense burners and other such pieces made in China and India covered with black spots and streaks that won't come off? Also, how can I remove ugly white polish residue stuck in embossed flatware patterns? June Wilcox, Lexington , Ky.

Use paint stripper on gilded or painted brass surfaces.) **MAAS Fine Polishing Creme**, which is non abrasive, nonflammable and nondrying, also removes caked-on residue from any sterling, stainless, or silver plated flatware or hollowware pieces embellished with embossed or elaborate patterns. Follow these directions:

- Lay the pieces in a drain closed sink or suitable tin or aluminum pan
- Pour enough boiling water over the pieces to completely cover them, letting them soak. Replace the boiling water if necessary
- After soaking, take a piece out (which needn't be dried) and rub **MAAS** polish on the piece and into the embossments.
- Take a soft toothbrush covered with a T-shirt material (into which **MAAS** has previously been rubbed to produce a jeweler's cloth) and simply brush and polish the embossments clean, which will leave the silver looking beautiful and brand-new.
